

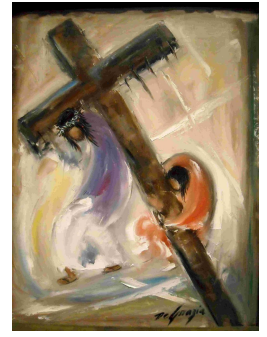
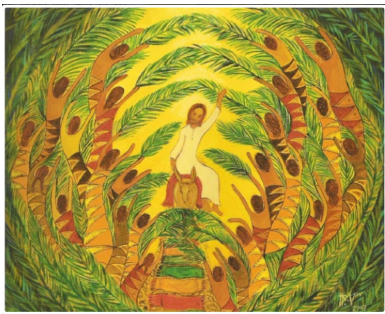


Grain
