Since 1995, seventeen-year-olds have been prosecuted within the adult criminal justice system. Throughout the years, many states have overturned their policy and now Wisconsin is one of the last 3 states in the nation to continue to have this policy in place. Our work at Raise The Age Wisconsin

is about passing legislation in Wisconsin to put all seventeen-year-olds back into the youth justice system. We invite you to JOIN US! During this webinar, you will be connected to facts and resources that emphasize why Raising the Age in Wisconsin is safer for youth and communities, in addition to being more cost effective, and equitable. You will also hear from individuals with lived experience about the real-life implications of our current law.
