Constitutional Convention, Water, Trafficking, FoodShare

Constitutional Convention: We put a lot of effort in to stopping the resolution to call for a U.S. Constitutional Convention but it passed. The good news is that we have built more awareness and if the needed number of states vote for the same resolution moving us toward a national vote, we will be even more ready. **Here are the voting results of your**

Glorias

Water: Over the last year, we supported a bill that would make it easier for public utilities to assist people with low incomes to get lead out of their pipes between the streets and their homes to protect drinking water. The bill passed in the assembly.

Anti-sex trafficking: For a few years we have supported a bill formerly called Safe Harbor to decriminalize youth under 18 caught in "prostitution" for the first time so that they would be treated as victims in need of services. The bill passed out of committee in the assembly.

We also supported a bill that would mandate that commercial driving classes in tech schools and driving schools include training on how to identify human trafficking and report it. The bill passed in the assembly.

FoodShare: We supported a bill that would launch a pilot program to provide discounts to certain households that are eligible for FoodShare benefits with discounts on fresh produce and other healthy foods. The bill passed in the assembly.
