The Governor's Task Force on Climate Change, spearheaded by Lieutenant Governor Mandela Barnes, begins hosting Public Listening Sessions next Tuesday, June 23, 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm. We here at LOPPW want you to be prepared.

Background Information—What are the goals of the State Climate Action Campaign?

- **Long Term:** By the end of Governor Evers' first term, Wisconsin has a clear, actionable plan to equitably meet 100% carbon-free electricity by 2050. Identify other ways to implement bold, equitable climate policy in the administration.
- **Short Term:** Through the Task Force on Climate Change public hearings and comment period, help show public support from Wisconsinites who want to see bold, equitable climate solutions from Wisconsin.

Moving Forward—What happens next? This is where Wisconsin needs your help and participation. To meet these goals, members of the community need to attend these public hearings, listen and learn from the stories of others, and even share their own experiences with climate issues in Wisconsin. There is so much going on in the news right now, but **this is our moment** as a state to mobilize and act, to discuss climate change and create bold and equitable climate solutions.
