



2020 Wisconsin Voting Overview

General Voting Information

- Voters can register to vote online or by mail until October 14th, at the clerk's office until October 30th, or at their polling place on election day.
 - All voters must provide a proof of residency when registering to vote. Find qualifying proof of residency forms [here](#).
- You can vote in person from 7:00am - 8:00pm on November 3rd at your designated polling place.
 - Find your designated polling place [here](#).
- You must bring a Photo ID in order to vote. A list of qualifying Photo IDs can be found [here](#).
- If voters do not want to vote in person, every eligible voter has the right to vote using an absentee ballot or vote in-person absentee.

Voting with an Absentee Ballot

- Wisconsin voters interested in voting with an absentee ballot can request an absentee ballot [here](#).
 - LOPPW recommends that voters request a ballot by October 17th.
- Complete the Absentee Ballot in the presence of a witness. A witness's signature and address are required for your vote to be counted. Complete the ballot and follow all directions closely.
- Return your ballot by mail by the recommended October 25th, in person to your city clerk by October 30th, or at your polling place/central count location on election day. LOPPW discourages voters from returning ballot to their polling place/central count location on election day.

Voting In-Person Absentee (Early Voting)

- Locate your municipal clerk's office or other designated early voting location.
- Check the dates and times available for early voting. Most cities allow early voting from October 20th to October 30th, but this varies by municipality.
- Make sure you bring a valid photo ID with you to vote (see "General Information" above).
- Request an In-Person Absentee Ballot and complete ballot in office.

Important Voting Deadlines

- **October 14th** – Last day for voters to register to vote by mail or online at [MyVote Wisconsin](#).
- **October 17th** – LOPPW's recommended deadline to request an Absentee Ballot.
- **October 20th** – Date municipalities can open in-person absentee Voting. However, in-person absentee voting schedule varies by municipality. Most in-person absentee voting ends Oct. 30th.
- **October 25th** – LOPPW recommended deadline to mail in absentee ballots.
- **October 30th** – Last day to register to vote at your Municipal Clerk's office.
- **November 3rd** – Election day for in-person voting. Polls open from 7:00am – 8:00pm.
